## CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT

The Apartment building on Seneca Rd. did not warrant a fire inspection since all of the apartment units have individual access to outdoors and separate access to their space in the basement.

## BARILLO PARK WATER FOUNTAIN

The water fountain is in and will be installed when time permits.

The sign for Barillo Park will be installed on May 21<sup>st</sup> and will be covered until the Memorial Day Ceremony. A ceremony will be held at 8:00 AM on May 27<sup>th</sup> with the Police, Fire, Village Board and Barillo family in attendance. At that time the sign will be uncovered and the fire department will place a wreath on the memorial. The Barillo committee will plan a picnic in the park for sometime in July.

#### **BRIDGE UPDATE**

The Mayor attended a meeting for information on the bridge work. The bridge will close on May 28<sup>th</sup>. The water line is now in placed under the river. Next week a temporary sidewalk on Rt. 36 will be complete. Cameron Ave will not have access to Seneca Rd. To access Cameron, residents will drive down Mary St to Cameron. The traffic light at Bethesda and Rt. 36 will have to be adjusted for the bus traffic that will be directed to that intersection.

#### SPRING CLEAN UP

The Village spring clean up will be the week of May 20<sup>th</sup> for the whole week. Residents may put out their yard waste at any time during the week.

#### BRIAN FRIEDLAND - WATER LINE

Mr. Friedland would like to have an answer from the board if they were going to reimburse him in any way for damages done to his property as discussed in last month's meeting. He would like to know what the procedure to determine whether it is the City's water line or the residents line that is in need of repair. Does an individual have to pay to have their line pulled up only to find that it was the City's line that was damaged? Mayor Falci stated that the Village makes the best educated diagnosis based on what has happened in the past. Mayor Falci stated that the City will replace the apron and sidewalk.
